EMPHASIS AREAS

Students may complete **one or two** of the following emphasis areas while fulfilling the requirements for a B.A. or B.S. in political science. These "tracks" help students organize a cohesive set of courses in areas that interest them the most. Emphasis area selections must be made at least one month in advance of your anticipated graduation date. The department verifies that you have **completed four of the qualifying courses*** for the selected emphasis area and notifies the Registrar so it can be included on your final transcript.
